- 3. Type or print legibly. Illegible applications will be deemed incomplete.
- 4. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered. No exceptions.
- 5. A thank you card sent by awardee to the Williams family is required before funds are distributed.
- 6. Students cannot re-apply for the scholarship they have previously been awarded.

PURPOSE

The D. J. Williams Graduate & Professional School Scholarship was established in 2020. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that have completed their undergraduate studies, and are enrolled in graduate and professional degree programs at accredited colleges and universities in the USA. The D. J. Williams Graduate & Professional School Scholarship principally targets students who will be classified as graduate and professional students in the Fall quarter/semester of 2023. Only one award is given annually.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in community programs, including but not limited to volunteer hours. This scholarship is not renewable, but is awarded annually provided funds are available.

TIMELINE

- Open from April 1, 2023 at 12:00 a.m. (PST) until November 22, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. (PST).
- Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
- Applicants are notified only if awarded a scholarship by November 22, 2023.

• Financial award to be applied in Fall of 2023, on or before December 5, 2023.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The D. J. Williams Graduate & Professional School Scholarship awards a scholarship based on a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, References, Leadership Experience, Personal Essay and Financial Need. Wholeness Ministries International, Inc. will pay scholarship funds directly to the recipient's academic institution. Scholarships are awarded annually and only to one recipient in the amount of \$500. The D. J. Williams Graduate & Professional School Scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender, religious affiliation, or sexual orientation. The Scholarship awarded is based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria. To honor the life, legacy, and 60+ year ministry of Bishop D. J. Williams, preference will be given to students who are pursuing theological education.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be admitted to a graduate/professional degree program in the Fall quarter/semester of 2023.
- Applicants must currently have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be current registered full-time students at an accredited college/university in the USA.
- Special consideration will be given to applicants who display financial need.
- Scholarship application is due by **November 22, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. (PST).**

APPLICATION PROCESS

Scholarship Applicants MUST provide:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing (most recent unofficial transcript accepted).
- A resume.
- A letter of recommendation from an academic advisor or professor.
- A letter of recommendation from an employer, pastor, or other community leader.
- Proof of financial need Official Course & Fee statement from the academic institution.
- An essay response: 750-word maximum, answering the following prompts:
 - 1. Describe your personal and academic journey up to this point. Please highlight reasons for your current academic pursuit.
 - 2. How do you understand a sense of "call" or "commitment" to this work?
 - 3. Please describe the relationship between "service" and "leadership" in your life experience and professional/educational field.
 - 4. How will this scholarship award meet or relieve your financial need? Please describe your financial investment in this degree pursuit and/or any hardships or financial challenges.
